Mission

The Good Samaritan Ministry is a non-profit, non-denominational charity that serves the poor and those coping with emergencies in Slidell, Alton and Pearl River.

Established since 1993, it is an outreach ministry of St. Luke the Evangelist Catholic Church and St. Margaret Mary Catholic Church.

Funding

The ministry is funded by tithing donations from St. Luke the Evangelist Catholic Church and Saint Margaret Mary Catholic Church in addition to private donations.

Over 99% of donated resources go to serving those in need!

Services

People in need are seen by appointment and must provide adequate information to establish their need before assistance is given.

All information is verified.

Assistance is limited to once per year.

The ministry provides help to pay bills associated with the necessities of life including housing, utilities, and gas. Good Sams acts as a mediator by connecting those in need with emergency and specialty services, including: dental, home repair, prescription consulting, and counseling services. We have volunteers who offer tutoring to struggling grade school students. Summer Camp scholarships are awarded. The Good Samaritans operates an emergency food pantry. In August, a school supplies program provides comprehensive supplies for needy children. In November, Thanksgiving food baskets are distributed with an emphasis on the elderly and those on a fixed income. The Ministry partners with Project Christmas to help provide a Merry Christmas to hundreds of children and elderly in East St. Tammany Parish.

The entire staff is comprised of volunteers working in office space donated by St. Luke the Evangelist Catholic Church.
